FIRST CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

What is the Conference about?

How do museum and heritage practitioners address a past rife with oppression, pain and conflict? How do we react when a movement is sparked by a monument? What is our part in the debate about who depicts whose culture and how? What can and can't you say in the public domain? How do we address power relations implicit in representation? Are we interested in multiple perspectives and presenting a contested narrative? What do we preserve and what do we discard? How do we deal sensitively with human remains?

This National Conference will be a platform for engagement on how these issues play out in real terms in our sites throughout the country in exhibitions, collections, conservation decisions and education programmes. 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How can I contribute?

- Present on an aspect of the theme
- Present a short, general "Show and Tell" session

Presentation on the theme

We are looking for research papers or case studies that relate to an aspect of the theme. Suggestions are:

- How do we represent and interpret our contested past (in programmes, exhibitions, design, presenting different points of view)?
- Movements around monuments (recent debates about what should happen to monuments that depict colonial history. Can monuments be reimagined?)
- How do our collections reflect (and preserve?) our contested past? (dealing with human remains, collections that reflect outdated ways of thinking. What do we discard and what do we preserve?)

How did you deal with one of the issues outlined above in your museum? Perhaps you know about a related issue that you can shed some light on? We are open to all topics relevant to the theme so if you have an idea not covered by the blurb above, propose it! 15 minutes long. You must be available on <u>Tuesday 24 October</u>.

Show and Tell presentation

Do you have a project, marketing strategy, education programme, outreach initiative or ANYTHING interesting that you would like to share with us? Put together a **10 minute** "Show and Tell" session and come and tell us about it. Note: These presentations do NOT need to relate to the theme. **You must be available on Thursday 26 October.**

- All presenters must please still register and pay for the Conference (at least to attend their presentation day) to allow the opportunity for one-on-one engagement between delegates and presenters and to make the Conference financially viable. Unfortunately, you will not be put on the programme if you have not paid your Conference fees by 30 August 2017.
- If your proposal to contribute is accepted, you will be notified by end of July and you commit to
 presenting at and attending the Conference (or part thereof). If you cancel later than <u>1 September 2017</u>,
 your Conference fees will not be reimbursed.
- All presentations must be made available in text form electronically for possible publication after the Conference.
- All proposals will be considered but the final choice rests with the organising committee.
