

# THE NIGHT OF THE DEAD MOON TOUR

### Monday 23 September.

9:00 Meet at Talana Museum .

Depart for Visit to Fort Pine built by Royal engineers in 1878 to defend the Buffalo river frontier.

12:00 Arrive at Nxala Ranch . Light lunch and visit to bushman paintings.

14:30 Visit Rorkes Drift battlefield. Experience the battlefield at the same time of the day as they were preparing for the Zulu Attack.

15:30 Drinks on deck at Rorkes Drift hotel overlooking Buffalo river and drift.

Depart 16:45 for Isandlwana.

17:30 Arrive Isandlwana battlefield.

“Night of the Dead Moon” tour at Isandlwana battle site.

Snacks and special “Isandlwana rum knock-out”.

Overnight at Elandsheim with braai and drinks around the bonfire. Dinner included. Bring own drinks.

Special accommodation cost R295 B&B for own account.

### Tuesday 24 September.

8:30 Meet at Elandsheim for departure to

Elandskraal church and the story of the German missionary settlement.

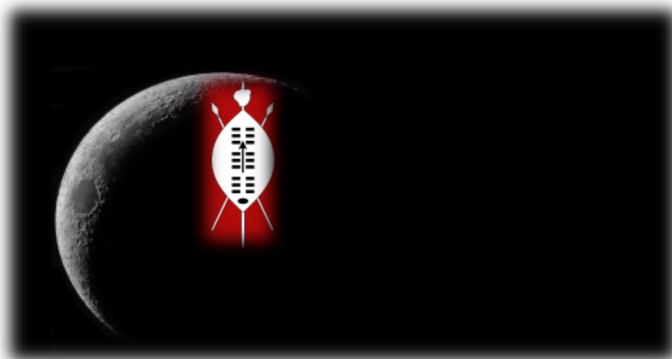
Spear sharpening site near iSibindi.
