
TUNGAAT MUSEUM GETS GU AHEAD



At a sitting of the eThekwini Municipal council, the long awaited proposal to convert the old railway station building in railway street, was given the green light. This project and the consultation process will soon commence, after many requests and calls over the years from the Tongaat Community and councillors.
