

## SAIA-KZN HERITAGE COMMITTEE: PETER LOUIS AWARD 2022.

### Introduction.

The award was established in 2004 by the Architectural Heritage Committee (AHC). It honours Peter Louis, a professional Quantity Surveyor and long-standing member of the Heritage Committee, who died in 2002. Previous recipients of the award have been an architect, a building contractor, an artist, a municipal administrator, a city councillor, and an archivist.

The current KZN region of the South African Institute of Architects has revived the Award to promote, foster and advance the conservation of the built environment of KwaZulu-Natal.

Winners will be selected from public nominations. A presentation ceremony will be held during Heritage Month in September 2022.

### Selection criteria.

Nominees must meet the following criteria:

- Individuals, groups or organisations making worthwhile contributions to conservation of the built environment, eg. to buildings, structures and places, whether tangible or intangible, anywhere in KZN.
- Nominees (Individuals / organisation / institutions) must be active in the heritage field, and may include municipalities, management authorities, conservancies, academia, institutes, and communities.
- Contributions can be through active physical promotion, preservation, research and/or protection of the built environment in KZN.

### Terms and conditions.

- Nominations from individuals, organizations, congregations, communities and institutions will be accepted.
- Each nomination must be accompanied by a fully completed Nomination Form.
- Nominees should be contactable by telephone, cell phone or email.
- The SAIA-KZN Heritage Committee reserves the right to make amendments to the process and procedures.
- Completed nominations can be delivered to SAIA-KZN offices at 160 Bulwer Rd, Glenwood, Durban or emailed to [media@kznia.org.za](mailto:media@kznia.org.za)
- The SAIA-KZN Heritage committee may choose to award more than one person or organisation.

### The adjudication.

After the closing date for nominations, the SAIA-KZN Heritage Committee will appoint an independent selection panel to assess the submissions and make their recommendation to the Heritage Committee for this award. The winner and nominator will be consulted to decide the details for the award ceremony to be held in Glenwood.
